Overview

Weston Park opened more than 45 years ago has recently undergone one of the biggest overhauls in the site's history. The hospital is one of only four dedicated cancer hospitals in the countryand provides chemotherapy and radiotherapy to thousands of patients from across South Yorkshire and beyond.

The £6.7 million project saw the wards (Ward 2 and Ward 3) being completely gutted before being brought up to a modern standard, with new equipment, beds and furnishings and will be designed to be patient-friendly.

Each ward will have 30 beds and new single rooms will be available, allowing patients to be checked in discreet areas, offering more privacy.

47 Vistamatic standard vision panels were a supply only to the project at Weston Park Hospital, they were open/close vision screens used for bedrooms for the benefit of the hospital staff to observe patients whilst minimising the disruption to the service users, whilst allowing them more privacy.
